

## **MOVE-OUT SCHEDULE**

**In-the-water display areas:** Move-out will begin at 6 p.m. Sunday, April 18 and must be completed by noon Monday, April 19.

Exhibitors who are unable to move promptly will be subject to additional handling and storage charges.

**Booth and dryland:** Move-out will begin at 6 p.m. Sunday, April 18 and must be completed by noon Monday, April 19.

### **SHOW HOURS:**

Thursday, April 15: Noon - 7 p.m.

Friday, April 16: Noon - 7 p.m.

Saturday, April 17: 10 a.m. - 7 p.m.

Sunday, April 18: 10 a.m. - 6 p.m.

**SHOW OFFICE:** The office will be staffed from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. April 12 through April 18, and 9 a.m. to noon on Monday, April 19.

**SECURITY:** There will be security at the Lido Marina Village area during and after show hours, beginning Friday, April 9 and ending Monday, April 19.

**MERCHANDISING POLICY:** Only those items related to the marine industry, including financing and insurance companies, will be allowed as exhibitors. No items that are offensive or create a noise problem will be allowed. If you have any questions regarding the display of items not mentioned in your show contract, please contact us before the move-in date. Items not covered in your contract may not be displayed, including free marine publications.

A broker or boat dealer must represent used vessels for sale that are displayed.

**BUSINESS LICENSE/SALES TAX:** The City of Newport Beach requires all exhibitors to obtain a Newport Beach Business License prior to conducting or representing a business at this event. Additionally, all exhibitors holding a California Seller's Permit must file a *BT-530-B* form with their regularly scheduled sales tax filing, separating all sales made at this show in the City of Newport Beach. Copies of these forms are available on our Web site. Please review the information carefully. Mail all the required documents to the City of Newport Beach, Attn: Susan Seviane, Business License Inspector, in a timely manner to ensure that you are in compliance with city code.
